GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF THIRD COUNSELLING
(OFFLINE MODE AT COLLEGE LEVEL)

- As per the Punjab Govt. notification, **only those candidates** will be eligible for admission in colleges of Education, for those *who have qualified Common Entrance Test (CET)*. The minimum Qualifying marks in the Common Entrance test will be 25% (for SC/ST candidates, minimum marks will be 20%).
- **No candidate can be admitted through counselling, who has not qualified the Common Entrance Test (C.E.T.).**
- 85% of seats will be reserved for Candidates from within the State of Punjab and 15% of seats will be open to candidates of other States/U.Ts on the basis of merit of CET prepared on All India basis excluding Punjab. The eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidate must be a resident of Punjab State in terms of the Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-11Br.) letter No. 1/3/95-3PP-11/96 19, dated 6th June 1996 and letter No. 1/3/95-3PP-11/80, dated 1st January 1999.
- Admission to the seats under 15% (All India) quota will be done as per the Reservation Policy provided by the Constitution of India/Central Govt.
- If a sufficient number of candidates belonging to reserved category/ categories are not available, the vacant seats will be offered to candidates in the open category. Likewise, if seats under the 15% category remain vacant, these would be transferred to the 85% category and vice-versa. Further, if suitable candidates are not available in any one of the sub-categories of reserved categories, the candidates from the other sub-categories will fill up the seats so available and if they are not available in any sub-category, then seats shall be filled up from general/open category candidates.
- A candidate claiming a seat in the Reserved Category will automatically have the right to be considered in the General Category according to his/her open Merit in the entrance test provided they have at least 50% marks at the undergraduate or postgraduate level.
- Likewise, if seats under the 15% (All India) category remain vacant, these would be transferred to the 85% category (Punjab Quota).
- Seats up to 70% of sanctioned intake at Malwa Central College of Education for Women, Ludhiana shall be reserved for rural women candidates who are bona fide residents of the State of Punjab.

PROCEDURE OF COUNSELLING:

- The admission will be made as per the procedure and guidelines laid down in the prospectus of Joint B.Ed. Admission Punjab -2025 and Notification of Govt. of Punjab for B.Ed. Admission 2025 (Punjab Government Notification No. HED-EDU10M.L/19/2022-3edu/E-316266/1/1105687/2025 dated 21-05-2025)
- Institute shall fill up vacant seats in third counselling on the basis of a merit list of applicants who had applied to college through its scheduled counseling in a transparent manner.
- **Firstly, the counseling for science subjects will be held.** The seats falling vacant in the science category will be converted into Arts category. After that, the counseling will start for the Arts category.
- In the **first instance, counselling of the All India category** will be held. The seats falling vacant in the All-India category will be converted into 85% state category.
- After that, the counselling for Punjab Quota will be held.
- The checking and verification of documents shall be the responsibility of the college.
